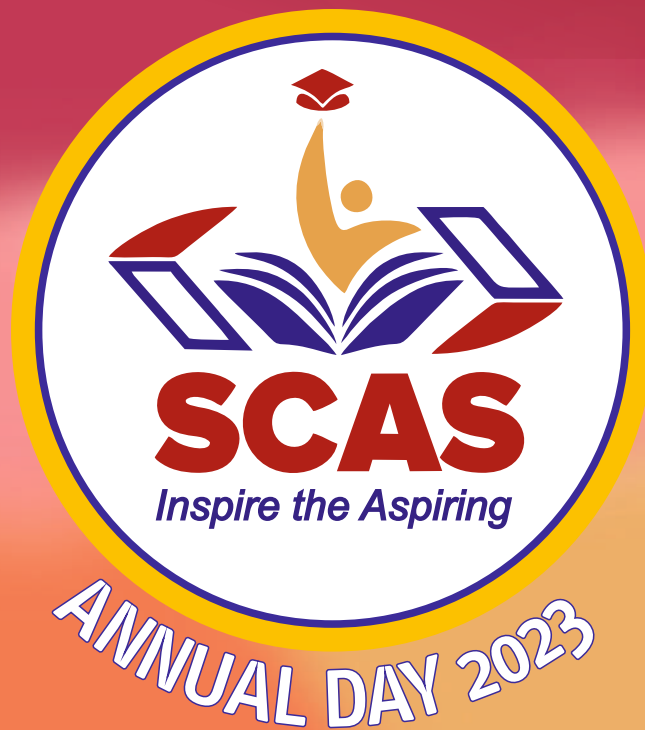

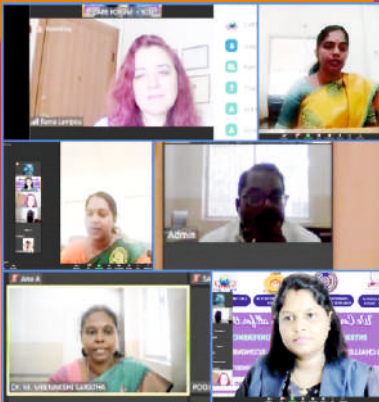
"Corporate Expectation from Budding Professionals"

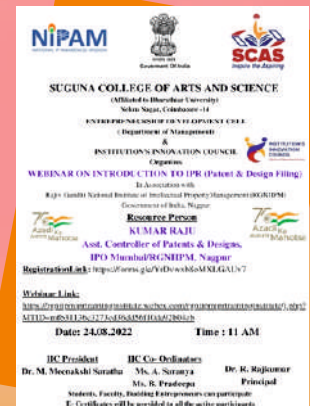


Guest Lecture on Mental Health – Myths and Facts

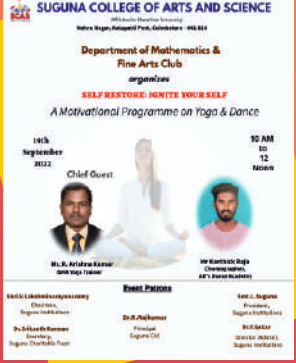
Orientation Programme - Charting the Future with Enhanced Communication Skills

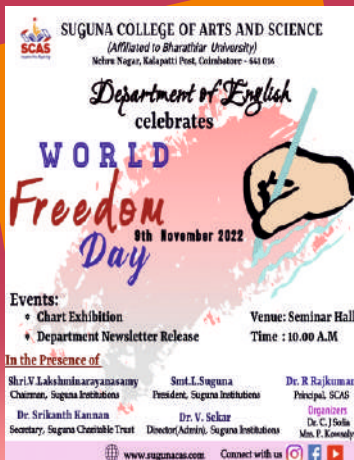
A Motivational Programme on Yoga and Dance - Self Restore: Ignite Yourself

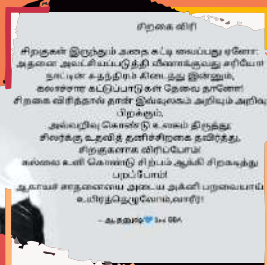
